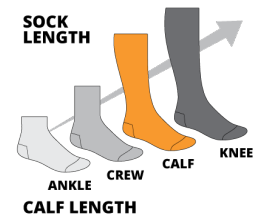

SUSTAINABLE INNOVATION FOR BETTER DURABILITY

We at UphillSport love the Nordic nature and named this sock after Hetta village in most northern part of Finland. Sock is made with a unique innovative 4-layer structure for better durability, breathability and warmth. 41% of used materials are upcycled. This is UphillSport's way of sustainable functionality.

Hetta trekking sock has 41 % Upcycled wool tri-blend from Recover system. Recover yarns are produced from textile waste, no chemicals are added, no water used and near zero CO2 emissions in the yarn production. Merino wool is certified with Nativa traceability program. Innovative multi-layer system makes the sock more durable and lasts longer in use. Product is 100% suitable for textile recycling.

All our products are produced in our own factory in Finland since 1996. We are certified to the association for Finnish work and have the permit to use a Finnish key flag on our products. UphillSport has a sustainability program for materials, environment, energy and social. Strategy's end goal is to change 50% of materials used in production to upcycled or traceable materials by 2022. Company is certified to ISO 9001:2015 and Nativa wool sustainability program, Nativa Protocol. All yarns used are OEKO-TEX certified.

UphillSport is leading the way in bringing upcycled yarns to our performance socks as a part of our sustainability program. UphillSport is the first socks factory in Europe to use Upcycled Recover- System's yarns in socks. UphillSport is the first European socks factory to be Nativa Protocol certified. Nativa Protocol is 100% traceable in all stages of the value chain.
